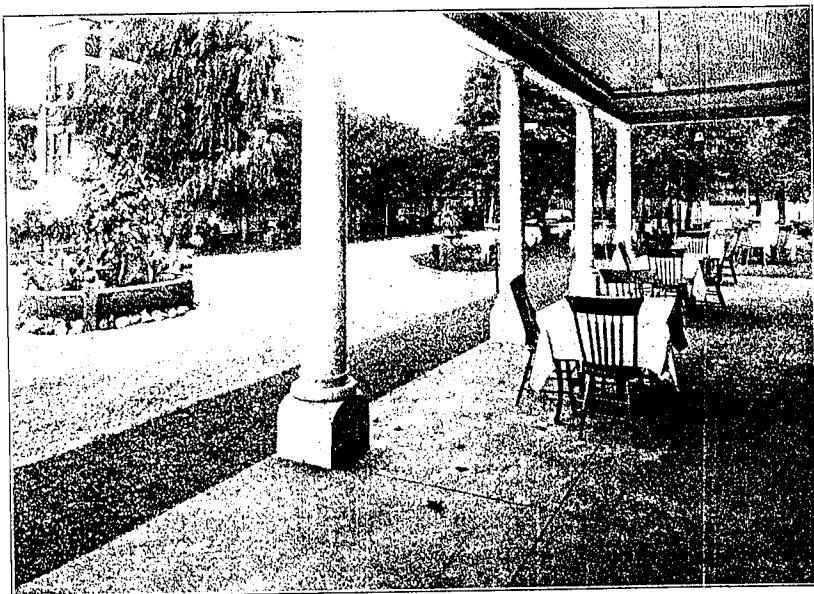
over ten years. He then determined to go into business in the catering line on his own account; and accordingly, opened up the handsome establishment which he has managed with great success since 1895.

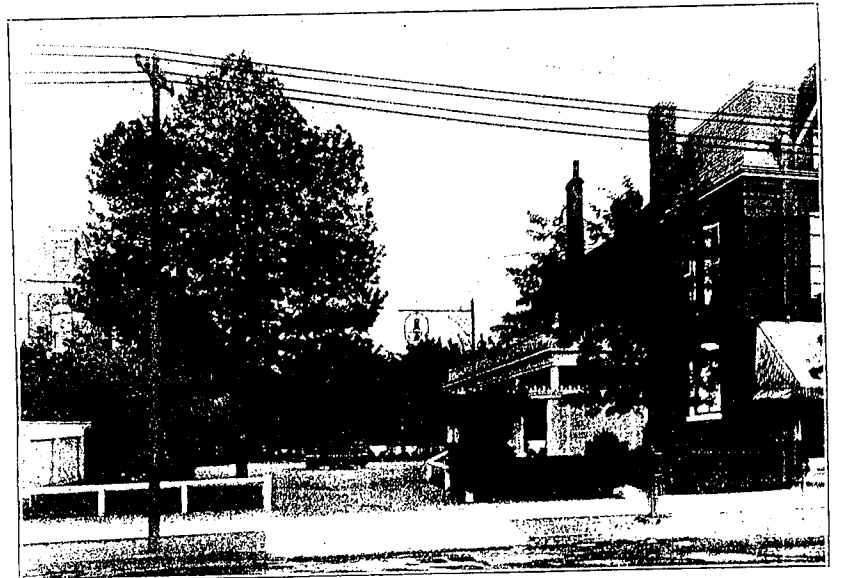

Mr. Anschuetz' place at Grand and Shenandoah Avenue embodies, in fine, everything that goes to the making

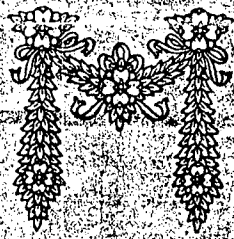
